- You are in rent arrears and struggling to pay your rent
- Your landlord is taking legal action against you due to rent arrears
- You are facing money and/or debt problems
- You are on benefits or low income and are struggling to pay housing costs and other bills
- You need help to understand what benefits you are entitled to
- You need help and support with a benefit claim

Making Advice Work

Making Advice Work is a partnership between Shelter Scotland, Caledonia, Fairfield and Sanctuary Housing Associations and is funded by the Scottish Legal Board. The partnership aims to prevent homelessness of tenants in member housing associations in the Perthshire and Dundee City area.

The service provides independent, face-to-face advice, support and advocacy if you are struggling to sustain a tenancy or facing homelessness. Our aim is to work with you and your landlord to help you to remain in your property.

Shelter Scotland will provide expert impartial advice on housing, money, debt or benefits issues. Where a need for more specialised help is identified, we will refer you on to the relevant agency.
